### WHAT IS THE NEED?

On January 12, 2010 a magnitude 7.0 earthquake struck just outside of Port-au-Prince, the capital city of Haiti. It is currently believed that more than 230,000 people were killed as a direct result of the earthquake and over one million are displaced, making Haiti the largest refugee camp in the world. Haiti's population of orphans was over 400,000 prior to the quake; one can only imagine how many vulnerable children there are now.

Upon returning from Haiti recently, FEI President and Founder, Joe Anfuso, remarked that this disaster was significantly "larger than any he had ever seen". The IDB estimated rebuilding costs to be upwards of \$14 billion. When viewed in relation to the size of Haiti's population and economy, this earthquake will most likely be the most destructive natural disaster in modern times.

Forward Edge believes that **where there is great need, there is great opportunity!** Through our partnerships with Restoration Ministries in Jacmel Haiti, FEI is able to serve those in desperate need of Christ's love. Family doctors, pediatricians, physical therapists, nurses and other medical personnel are needed to serve at the local clinic. Others are needed to help rebuild and repair homes and to minister to the children who are cared for each day at the feeding program. The opportunities to serve and minister to the community of Jacmel are endless for anyone with a loving heart and willing hands.

Thank you for helping us bring hope and encouragement to the people of Jacmel.

### WHAT WILL WE BE DOING?

Teams will be given the opportunity to serve both relationally and physically. Teams should expect to work on various building projects, assist with the local feeding program and serve during the worship services. Projects will be determined on a variety of criteria, but the primary deciding factors will be going where the need is greatest and funding is available.

**ACCOMODATIONS:** Teams will be staying at The Loving Light Hotel in Jacmel, Haiti. The hotel offers the most basic of sleeping arrangements and bathroom facilities. Team members will need to be prepared to share rooms, bathrooms and beds with other team members. They will also need to bring a light blanket and a towel.

**SCHEDULE:** You will fly into Port-au-Prince. Typically teams arrive on a Saturday. After orientation that evening, teams will attend church on Sunday morning. Sunday afternoon will be a day of rest and preparation for the upcoming week. Monday - Friday the team will work on various projects. After debriefing on Friday, the team will return home Saturday.

**COST:** The fee of **\$745 per person** covers food, lodging and ground transportation in Haiti. Practical preparatory materials, an experienced on-site facilitator and complete logistical coordination are also included. Each team member should bring an additional **\$8** for one lunch out.

**PAYMENTS:** There is a \$100 non-refundable deposit due at the time of application submission. The non-refundable deposit will be applied towards your team fee. Payments can be paid by check or by credit card at [www.forwardedge.org](http://www.forwardedge.org) (Pay Team Fee) Make checks payable to: *Forward Edge International*. All payments need to reflect the **team member name and team number**.

**PASSPORT/TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:** Haiti requires a *passport* to be valid for at least 6 months beyond day one of your trip. A visa is not required for entry. FEI requires each team member to carry a travel insurance policy that will cost approximately \$20-25 per person. FEI will provide specific instructions regarding which flights should be purchased to and from Port au Prince, Haiti. FEI strongly encourages each team member to purchase airfare trip insurance with their airline tickets in the event that there is an interruption of the trip due to natural disaster or illness prior to departure.

**PREPARATION:** As soon as Forward Edge receives completed applications, we'll send you a team pack: T-shirt, training materials and information about Haiti. Please note: FEI strongly recommends that each team member checks with his or her doctor before embarking. We recommend current shots for **Tetanus and Typhoid and medication for Malaria**. Team members may also want to consider **vaccinations for Hepatitis A & B, Meningitis or H1N1**. **Again consult with your physician for the most up to date immunization recommendations.**
