WHERE ARE WE GOING?

Juarez, Mexico is just south of El Paso, Texas. As the largest US/Mexican border city (approximately 1.6 million people), there is a constant current of people and goods flowing through its gates; not only from the US into Mexico, but also from all of South and Central America into the States. The high traffic flow is vital to the economy of Juarez, but causes great social problems as well.



Over the years, Juarez has experienced foreign investment from the US and other countries. This has created a healthy amount of jobs for the Mexican people and has attracted Mexicans from all over the whole Chihuahua state. This tremendous increase in population has stimulated a lot of positive growth, but has also created a number of extremely

poor neighborhoods. The city's resources have also been strained because of the population explosion, and a good primary education is rare for most children.

But where there is need, there are also opportunities for God to glorify Himself! The church is alive and well in Juarez and is fighting to win this city for Christ, and they need your help.

WHAT ARE WE DOING?

You will be serving at Ebenezer Foursquare church in the Anapra District, which is one of the poorest neighborhoods in Juarez. Forward Edge teams have helped construct an amazing school where 180 students currently attend. Your team will help build one of the last rooms of the primary school. Additionally, you will interact with the students, participate in open-air evangelism and take daily prayer walks with church leaders, climbing a local mountain to pray over the city.

COST

The team fee for this 7-day trip is **\$495**. This fee covers preparatory materials, accommodations, meals, ground transportation, some construction materials and an on-site Facilitator. If you plan to fly into the area, make sure you book flights to El Paso, Texas (ELP). The FEI Facilitator and a representative from the church will pick you up and take you across the border to Juarez, Mexico. Please contact **Your Group Leader** regarding travel arrangements.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Your host church is Ebenezer Foursquare church pastored by Gilberto and Aida Mauricio. The Mauricios have a fantastic vision for the property God has given them, and enthusiastically welcome your visit.

PASSPORT / IDENTIFICATION

Mexico requires a *passport* and a *valid photo ID*. **You must have your identification with you at all times.**
