



MEXICO AT A GLANCE

Trigo y Miel (Wheat and Honey), a Forward Edge ministry in Oaxaca, focuses on serving children and their families in the very poor and underdeveloped area near the city garbage dump on the outskirts of Oaxaca City. The people who live in the *colonias* (neighborhoods) have come from smaller villages in search of a better life. Most families are dealing with severe unemployment, poor education, and poor housing. For many, daily life is focused on survival with little hope for a prosperous future. They desperately need to know the One who gives eternal hope!

Trigo y Miel (*TyM*) currently provides a healthy meal once a day, six days a week, to over 100 children. While the children are at *TyM* there are many opportunities for teams to serve, including helping with homework, teaching English or basic computer skills, and playing sports. In Oaxaca, the average child doesn't finish 7th grade, and less than 14% complete more than the 8th grade. On Saturday mornings, *TyM* directors Victor and Lety Velasco, teach Bible lessons to the children in the neighborhood, similar to having Sunday school.

Forward Edge is looking for partners to help *Trigo y Miel* bring lasting solutions—not just quick fixes—to poor, families in need within Oaxaca. One of our projects is to create dependable jobs and safe homes for this community and others through the creation of Earth Block homes. This initiative uses a machine that creates durable, safe bricks made from dirt, clay, sand, and only 8% cement at a fraction of the cost of normal building materials. Additionally, this initiative is providing jobs and training locals how to use the machine. We invite you to join us as we partner with God as He advances His work in Oaxaca!

PAYMENTS

A \$200 non-refundable deposit is due at the time of registration and will be applied towards your trip fee. Payments can be paid by check, by an ACH payment (please contact us), or online by creating an account at www.forwardedge.org. Make checks payable to: Forward Edge International. All payments need to reflect the team member name and team number.

TEAM MEMBER PREPARATIONS

IMMUNIZATIONS: The government of Mexico does not require any shots or immunizations to enter the country. Please consult a personal physician for any recommendations.

TEAM PACKS: Once registration is complete, Forward Edge will send the team packs. Each will include a t-shirt, a Mexico Team Member Manual, a devotional, and other Forward Edge items.

SCHEDULE: Each day your team will experience a morning devotional, an evening debrief, and relationship building opportunities through serving the local people.

PASSPORTS

A passport is required to enter Mexico. No other identification is needed. If you already have a passport, please be sure that the expiration date is at least six months past the date of your departure from Mexico. If you do not have a passport, please apply for one as soon as possible. Both the application and renewal processes can take up to 6-8 weeks.
