The Program

Create Hope Ghana began when Jonathan Haruna and Rhoda Wumbei (now our Ghana Program Directors) met a girl who couldn't attend school due to struggling family finances and a lack of cultural priority – 'girls don't need education' was a common belief. The family needed just \$1 to send her to school. Jonathan and Rhoda immediately helped and began sharing with this family and others the importance of education for girls.

Today, Create Hope Ghana is assisting over 600 children and their families with nutritious meals, quality education, mentoring, and a supportive community. Jonathan and Rhoda are also helping widows and their children find secure homes. Their work is driven by a deep love for Christ, motivating them to share the gospel and help others discover and pursue their God-given potential.



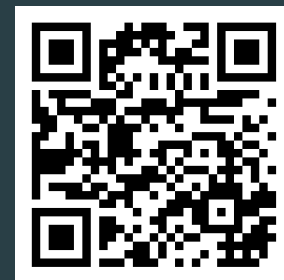
Trip Fee:

- Registration Deadline: 90 days before departure.
- Full balance due: 60 days before departure.

While You're There

Every Forward Edge team is designed to give you the opportunity to engage, serve, and learn from a community experiencing poverty. Each project is unique and may include various relational activities, local outreach, maintenance and construction projects. Trip Fee Includes

- Translators.

- Complete trip coordination provided by Forward Edge.

Trip Fee Does Not Include

- Flights to and from Ghana (Please contact your Team Coordinator prior to ticket purchase.)
- Luggage fees.
- Visa application fees.
- \$30 background check if necessary.
- Additional project materials (VBS, crafts, etc.) if needed.



Before You Go

Passport and Visa: US passport and Ghanaian visa (purchased 60 days prior to arrival) are required. The visa process requires mailing your passport to the US Embassy. Plan accordingly. If you already have a passport, please be sure that the expiration date is at least six months past the date of your departure from Ghana.

Immunizations: The government of Ghana requires all visitors obtain a yellow fever vaccination to enter the country. Please consult a personal physician or travel clinic for further recommendations.

Accommodations & Travel: In Ghana, you will be staying at a safe and secure guest house. Towels and linens will be provided.

Excursion/Cultural Day: Team members will visit Mole National Park. Mole is Ghana's first, largest and most prestigious protected area and holds outstanding natural, physical, historical and cultural resources.
