The Program

Our two programs in Cuba—Good Samaritans Club (Club del Buen Samaritano) in El Cobre and Spring of Blessings (Manantial de Bendiciones) in Santiago—are transforming lives by providing essential support to over 300 children. Through these programs, children receive a nutritious meal each week, tutoring assistance, and spiritual guidance to help them grow in their faith and reach their full, God-given potential.

Beyond meeting physical needs, these programs create a space where children experience God's love and find hope for the future. By investing in their well-being, education, and spiritual development, we are equipping the next generation with the tools they need to thrive.



Trip Fee:

\$1,575 per person

- Plus \$125 cost of Cuban Entry Visa
- A \$200 per person non-refundable deposit is due at the time of registration and is applied toward your trip fee and visa fee.
- Registration Deadline: 120 days before departure.
- Full balance due: 90 days before departure

While You're There

Every Forward Edge team is designed to give you the opportunity to engage, serve, and learn from a community experiencing poverty. Each project is unique and may include various relational activities, local outreach, maintenance and construction projects. Incorporating your team's skills, talents, and passions are strongly encouraged. Communicate your ideas with your Team Coordinator.

Trip Fee Includes

- Meals, lodging, ground transportation, and some project materials.
- Secondary Int'l Medical Insurance.
- Translators
- Trained Forward Edge Facilitator.
- Team Packs: T-shirt, manual, etc.
- Complete trip coordination provided by Forward Edge.

Trip Fee Does Not Include

- Flights to and from Cuba (Please contact your Team Coordinator prior to ticket purchase.)
- Luggage fees.
- \$125 visa application fees.
- \$30 background check if necessary.
- Additional project materials (VBS, crafts, etc.) if needed.





Before You Go

Passport and Visa: For entry into Cuba, a US passport and Cuban visa (purchased 120 days prior to arrival) are required. If you already have a passport, please be sure that the expiration date is at least six months past the date of your departure from Cuba.

Immunizations: Forward Edge recommends that all team members are current on their tetanus vaccination. Consult your personal physician for further guidance.

Accommodations & Travel: In Cuba, you will be staying at a safe and secure guest house. Towels and linens will be provided.

Excursion/Cultural Day: Team members will have the opportunity to visit Castillo de San Pedro de la Roca, explore the downtown Santiago de Cuba market, or have a beach day.
