Trip Fee Does Not Include

- Flights to and from Kenya (Please contact your Team Coordinator prior to ticket purchase)
- Luggage fees
- Visa application fees
- Additional project materials (VBS, crafts, etc.) if needed
- Required background check





Before You Go

Passport and Visa: For entry into Kenya, a US passport and Kenyan visa (purchased 30 days prior to arrival) are required. If you already have a passport, please be sure that the expiration date is at least six months past the date of your departure from Kenya.

Immunizations: Forward Edge recommends that all team members are current on their tetanus vaccination and obtain a yellow fever vaccination 10 days prior to the trip. Consult your personal physician for further guidance.

Accommodations & Travel: In Kenya, you will be staying at a safe and secure guest house. Towels and linens will be provided.

Excursion/Cultural Day: Team members will have the opportunity to participate in a 2-day safari to Maasai Mara National Reserve.
